From Raleigh/Durham take I 40 to Hillsborough and then Hwy 86 North.

From Burlington take Hwy 62 to Yanceyville and then Hwy 86 North.

From Greensboro take Hwy 29 North towards Danville them Hwy 86 South.

From Roanoke/Martinsville take Hwy 58 East towards Danville then Hwy 86 South.

From Lynchburg take Hwy 29 South towards Danville then Hwy 86 South.

From South Boston take Hwy 58 West to Hwy 29 Bypass South then Hwy 86 South.

There are two ways to come in off Hwy 86. One will take you downtown Providence. The other will take you in the back way to the festival. That is the way we have always gone. We think it is the best for several reasons. That is the way I am sending you.

On Hwy 86 look for a Collision Center, a NAPA store, and an ABC store. Turn between the ABC store and the Collision Center. If you are headed north- you will turn right. If you are headed south- you will turn left. I am not sure how far it is. All residential area until the festival, you can't miss it.

If there is a barricade blocking the road, go around it. This is for the parade. You will be coming in, at the end, of the parade route. (Check our website to see if there is a parade this year.) If there is, it will start at 10:00am. It usually lasts less than an hour. I suggest you don't try to come in between 10:00 and 11:00. You will have to sit and wait on the parade or interrupt it.

Turn left at the first driveway into the festival. You will have to drive behind a building. Turn back to the left to go down the hill to the track.
